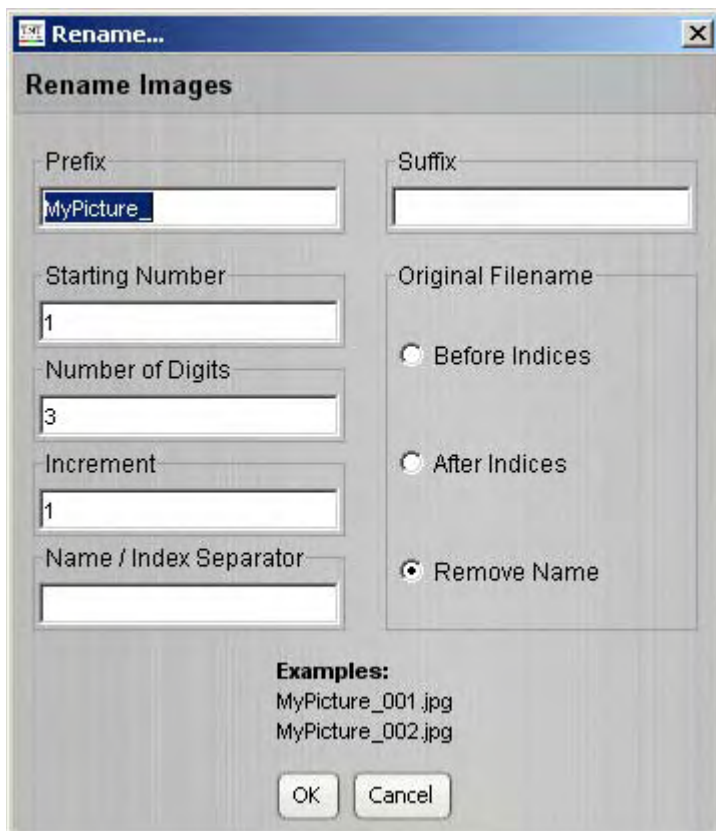




Position Sequence & Renaming files in ROES

- Load your images into ROES by clicking on the FOLDER button
- Click and drag you images to the sequence desired. As you drag an image, a blue vertical line will appear to show where the image will be placed.
- You can hide an image by right clicking on it and select “Hide Selected”
- Once you have the images positioned and sequenced in the desired order press Ctrl+A to select all images.
- Right click on any of the selected images and select “Rename”



- In the “Prefix” field you can define the value before the number. In this example we chose “MyPicture_”. Do not enter spaces and try to keep the prefix as short as possible.

- Enter a “Starting Number” and the Number of Digits” desired. In this example we entered a starting number of 1 and the value for the Number of Digits of 3. The Number of Digits is a “padding” values, thus 1 becomes 001.
- Finish with the “Increment” value. In this case we entered a value of 1.
- The resulting values are displayed in the Example.
